Inference, Prediction, Explain, Retrieve, Sequence, Summarise). dm, reservoir, As Scientists we will be investigating the different "States of Matter" We will look at what makes a solid, what Melt, freeze, chemicals and makes a liquid and what makes a gas. We will investigate where we find these different states of matter and how condense. pollution we can them both scientifically and in everyday life. We will create and conduct our own experiments to learn more. evaporate, As Geographers we will discover the mountains of Wales. This will involve us looking at which countries make up process, state. the UK, which UK country has the longest river and think about where we would find Wales. We will compare water, ice, water whether England or Wales has the longest river and also who has the highest mountain. This will involve vapor. investigating the water cycle. In PE we will develop the fundamental skills of balancing, running, jumping, hopping and skipping. Also, we will develop our ability to change direction with balance and control. We will be given the opportunity to explore how the body moves at different speeds as well as how to accelerate and decelerate.

As Musicians we will listen to a variety of music to encourage us to sing. This work will be done with staff from St Mary's College.

As Artists we will use Van Gogh as our inspiration by making and matching colours with increasing accuracy. We will use specific colour language e.g. tint, tone, shade, hue while choosing paints and implements appropriately. We will begin to plan and create different effects and textures with paint according to what they need for the task.

In RE we will be exploring the experience of family and how this still remains the first place for growth and development.
